TRAVEL STUDY

Over the course of twenty-one days we explored the Chinese culture and principals of art and design throughout various cities. We were privileged enough to collaborate with students in Dalian at the Luxun Academy of Fine Arts in preparation for a group show.

My experience in the Creative Services Department at Winona State University consisted of organizing layout, type, and graphics on posters, postcards, brochures, envelopes, business cards, pop-up banners, and folders among other items.

As designers, we would meet with a client half of the time otherwise through email to discuss project details, then the designs would usually go through a drafts and proofs process of sending the project back and forth from designer to client until the client approves the design to be sent to the Print Shop.

Many times the last step in this design process is queuing the pdf of the final design over to the platemaker to create plates for each color in the design. These plates then get sent down to the print shop for the production stage.

Most tasks in the Print Shop were production. Projects are printed either by the press or printer and usually cut down to final size and either hole-punched, bound by wire, stapled, shrink wrapped, or simply folded.

My tasks at the coffee shop ranged from running the cash register, making various drinks as a barista, working in the kitchen making paninis, serving plates, washing dishes, all the way to mopping floors.
